Bridge Table by Matthew Hilton

The contemporary Bridge table is a notably expressive piece, a fine example of British designer Matthew Hilton's ability to imbue his designs with both functional necessity and feeling.

It has solid oak or walnut-stained ash legs with a walnut or oak veneered top. The table has gently tapered legs with an outward facing curvature, the supporting frame arcs underneath the elliptical table top like a bridge, creating both leg room and the signature look of the piece.

Key Features

Solid wood base and chamfered veneered top

Available as 1.1 and 1.6 m top

1.1m table extends to 1.6m and sits a maximum of 6 people (1 leaf)

1.6m table extends to 2.5m and sits a maximum of 10 people (2 leaves- can be used singularly)

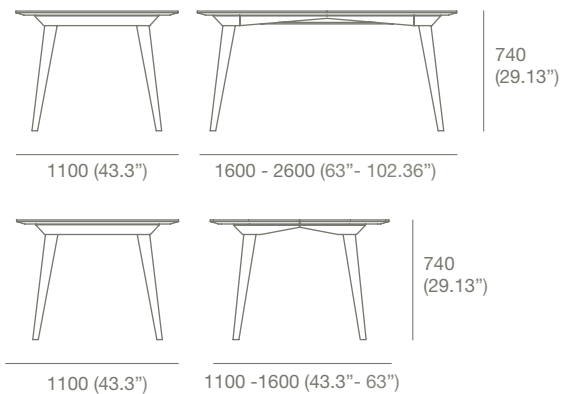
